

Trees and shrubs

Now through fall is the best time to plant trees and shrubs. Be sure you don't plant them too deeply. Dig your hole twice the diameter of the root ball but at the same depth. After planting, water thoroughly and keep moist the root ball until the soil freezes.

Evergreen trees will often drop their older, interior needles at the end of the season. This is a natural occurrence.

If your cedars have bagworms you should pick them off.

For your Flower beds You need to prepare a list of bulbs and order for planting in September and October.
