

Pick beans, cucumbers and other crops regularly so the plants will remain productive.

Onions are ready to harvest when their tops fall over naturally. You can cure onions in a dark well-ventilated area for two weeks. Store in mesh bags in a cool dry area.

Plant beets, broccoli, cauliflower, lettuce, peas, radishes, spinach, and turnips for a fall garden.

You can plant cover crops such as oats in open areas of the garden. Cover crops improve the soil and add organic matter to reduce soil erosion in winter. Oats germinate and grow quickly in a cool, wet fall. Plant your oats at 1.2 to 2.3 lb/1000 sq. ft.
